According to the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), The Gambia only had 2 MWof installed solar photovoltaic capacity at the close of 2022. Similarly, in the realm of wind energy, only small-scale projects initiated by private investors and non-governmental organizations are currently in operation.

Who owns a power plant in the Gambia?

These are operated by National Water and energy Company(NaWeC) and Global electric Group (GeG) - an independent Power Producer (iPP). effective installed capacity in The Gambia is around 65 mW. This is divided into two generation and transmission categories.

Is re a solution to energy problems in the Gambia?

Policy makers across africa have been among the last to embrace Re as a solu-tion to their energy problems. They are often locked into crisis management on a day-to-day basis.
