How can energy storage help the electric grid?

How many MW of energy storage capacity is needed by 2045?

The state is projected to need 52,000 MWof energy storage capacity by 2045 to meet electricity demand. "Energy storage systems are a great example of how we can harness emerging technology to help create the equitable, reliable and affordable energy grid of the future," said CEC Vice Chair Siva Gunda.

What is an energy storage system?

The Public Utilities Code defines an energy storage system as a commercially available technology that absorbs energy, storing it for a specified period, and then dispatches the energy.

How do energy storage projects work?

Energy storage projects capture power produced by wind and solar resources and discharge the energy back to the electric grid during times of peak demand. In California, electricity demand is highest in the late afternoon and early evening hours when the sun sets, causing solar resources to drop off before winds pick up later in the evening.
