Energy storage boiler combustion system

What are the different types of thermal energy storage systems?

Thermal energy storage (TES) systems store heat or cold for later use and are classified into sensible heat storage, latent heat storage, and thermochemical heat storage. Sensible heat storage systems raise the temperature of a material to store heat. Latent heat storage systems use PCMs to store heat through melting or solidifying.

Does thermal storage reduce the transient performance of a boiler?

Recently,Stefanitsis et al. have used the CFB model originally published in to evaluate the transient performance of a boiler after implementing a thermal storage in the form of hot bulk solids, and they concluded that the stabilization time for load changes is reduced when adding the storage.

How efficient is a thermal storage system?

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The equivalent round-trip efficiency of the entire process is 85.17%, which is a high level for energy storage systems. The efficiency is achieved because of the appropriate match between the heat sources and the thermal storage media. To illustrate the thermal performance of the integrated system, an exergy flow Sankey diagram is shown in Fig. 7.
