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The process is similar to a pumped-storage hydropower plant (HPP), with water substituted with concrete blocks and gravity doing the rest. The specific heat of concrete is a key factor considered by engineers and researchers in the design and optimisation of TES systems.

Storworks provides energy storage by storing heat in concrete blocks, charging when excess energy is available and discharging to provide energy when needed. The system can be heated by electricity, steam, or waste heat recovery, and can provide heat, steam, or electricity when paired with a conventional steam turbine.

If scaled up, the cement could hold enough energy in a home's concrete foundation to fulfill its daily power needs. Scaled up further, electrified roadways could power electric cars as they drive. A third approach utilises gravity energy storage. Concrete blocks weighing up to 35 metric tonnes are lifted using excess electricity to store energy as gravitational potential energy. The thermal energy storage technology developed by Storworks was demonstrated in collaboration with the Electric Power Research Institute and Southern Company. The 10 MWh electric energy storage solution was charged using heat from supercritical steam generated by the power plant. More than 80 energy charge and discharge cycles were ...

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
