These are the three main types of storage: Sensible heat storage is the most widely used. Water is often used as a carrier, since it has one of the highest volumetric heat capacities of natural existing materials.

Pumped hydropower storage represents the largest share of global energy storage capacity today (>90%) but is experiencing little growth.
