

Energy storage explosion-proof wall construction

What happens if a building explodes?

Fragmentation of brittle exterior wall components, namely unreinforced masonry and windows (glass), is the primary cause of injury and death when an occupied building is subjected to an external explosion.

What happens if a concrete wall explodes?

Condensation can form on concrete, which can slowly be absorbed into the concrete and eventually weaken the structure. Steel's ruggedness allows the wall to stand up to the explosion, and its malleability allows it to absorb some of the energy during a blast.

How long does a building take to load from an explosion?

The duration of loading on a building facade from external explosions is typically characterized in milliseconds (seconds/1,000). Forces resulting from internal explosion are significantly more complex to predict due to reflections and gas pressure venting.

Can Occupied buildings be exploded?

An occupied building is subjected to an external explosion. For this reason, the U.S. Department of Defense (UFC 4-010-01) and the ASCE blast standard (ref. 5) prohibit the use of un-reinforced masonry in the construction of new buildings.

Why is a blast wall important?

Steel's ruggedness allows the wall to stand up to the explosion, and its malleability allows it to absorb some of the energy during a blast. By its very nature, a blast wall protects the structure from only one side, and the blast wave can affect a structure from all sides and the top. When should a blast wall be used?

Can a building withstand a blast load without significant damage?

To design a building to withstand any possible blast load event without significant damage tends to be prohibitively expensive, and achieving the balance between the additional costs of blast protection and the costs associated with significant but acceptable damage is often challenging.
