

Why is energy storage oversupply a problem?

The expansion is driven mainly by local governments and lacks coordination with new energy stations and the power grid. In some regions, a considerable storage oversupply could lead to conflicts in power-dispatch strategies across timescales and jurisdictions, increasing the risk of system instability and large-scale blackouts.

But while approximately 192GW of solar and 75GW of wind were installed globally in 2022,only 16GW/35GWh (gigawatt hours) of new storage systems were deployed.

Is excessive energy storage a problem?

Spyros Foteinis highlights the acknowledged problem that an insufficient capacity to store energy can result in generated renewable energy being wasted (Nature 632 , 29; 2024). But the risks for power-system security of the converse problem -- excessive energy storage -- have been mostly overlooked.

Why is energy storage more cost-effective?

Moreover,increasing the renewable penetrationor CO 2 tax makes energy storage more cost-effective. This is because higher renewable penetrations increase the opportunities to use stored renewable energy to displace costly generation from non-renewable resources.

Why is energy storage important in a decarbonized energy system?

In deeply decarbonized energy systems utilizing high penetrations of variable renewable energy (VRE), energy storage is needed to keep the lights on and the electricity flowing when the sun isn't shining and the wind isn't blowing -- when generation from these VRE resources is low or demand is high.
