

Why is the optimal configuration of energy storage important?

In face of the randomness and volatility of the renewable energy generation and the uncertainty of the load power consumption in the new power system, the optimal configuration of energy storage is very important, so that it can effectively act as a flexible power source or load when the system fluctuates.

Does energy storage add value to the grid?

The following are some of the key conclusions found in this analysis: Energy storage provides significant value to the grid, with median benefit values by use case ranging from under \$10/kW-year for voltage support to roughly \$100/kW-year for capacity and frequency regulation services.

How to manage hybrid energy storage in a new power system?

To ensure the efficient management of hybrid energy storage, reduce resource waste and environmental pollution caused by decision-making errors, systematic configuration optimization model as well as value measurement of hybrid energy storage in the new power system are deeply studied in this paper.

Do energy storage valuation studies address resiliency?

Energy storage valuation studies walk cautiously around questions relating to the costs associated with power disruptions. They tend to focus more, if not entirely, on reliability questions rather than addressing the value of resiliency.

Is there a literature review of energy storage valuation studies?

Balducci et al.'s work [200], which forms the basis of the literature review that has been updated for this paper, provides documentation of numerous energy storage valuation studies and their results. Updates to this dataset include research published in 2018-2020 and studies focused on storage technologies other than BESSs, including PSH.

What is the taxonomy of services for energy storage valuation?

Balducci et al. (2018) presented a taxonomy of services for energy storage valuation that were stratified according to five major categories: bulk energy-based, ancillary-based, transmission-based, distribution-based, and customer-based services [200]. The taxonomy presented in [200] was built on a foundation established in [30].
