The pumped hydro energy storage station flexibility is perceived as a promising way for integrating more intermittent wind and solar energy into the power grid. However, this flexible operation mode challenges the stable and highly-efficient operation of the pump-turbine units.

What is pumped storage hydropower (PSH)?

Pumped storage hydropower (PSH) is a type of hydroelectric energy storage. It is a configuration of two water reservoirs at different elevations that can generate power as water moves down from one to the other (discharge), passing through a turbine. The system also requires power as it pumps water back into the upper reservoir (recharge).

What is pumped hydropower storage?

Pumped hydropower storage (PHS), also called pumped hydroelectricity storage, stores electricity in the form of water head for electricity supply/demand balancing. For pumping water to a reservoir at a higher level, low-cost off-peak electricity or renewable plants' production is used.

What is Fengning pumped storage power station?

The Fengning Pumped Storage Power Station is the one of largest of its kind in the world, with twelve 300 MW reversible turbines, 40-60 GWh of energy storage and 11 hours of energy storage, their reservoirs are roughly comparable in size to about 20,000 to 40,000 Olympic swimming pools.

Are pumped storage power stations a good long-term energy storage tool?

The high penetration of renewable energy sources (RESs) in the power system stresses the need of being able to store energy in a more flexible manner. This makes pumped storage power station the most attractive long-term energy storage tool today [4,5].
