The color ring inductance is the same as the four rings' color ring resistance, although the inductance is significantly less accurate than the resistance. The carbon sheet resistance is typically 5%, and the inductance is typically 10%. (the silver ring is the last ring). A frequent way is to place the silver ring on the far right.

What is the inductance of a red ring?

The second ring: black-represents 0 The third ring: Red-represents 2 zeros, but the "2" in the third ring is not a "significant digit", but means the number of "zeros" added after the first two significant digits. From this point of view, the inductance of this inductor should be 1000.

Why does the color ring inductor drop quickly?
