

Did envidity get permission to extract coal in Kosovo?

Kosovo's parliament ultimately decided not to grant Envidity permission to extract coal for the project, but that didn't keep Clark from chasing his Kosovo dream. The former general is now concentrating on renewable energy projects.

Could envidity find lignite in Kosovo?

Shortly thereafter, Envidity was granted a research license to look for lignite across one-third of Kosovo's territory. Can you make money from lignite in Kosovo?

The country has lots of coal, but it's hard to make any money from it. Kosovo is the world's fifth largest reserve of lignite, which is the lowest grade of coal. Lignite has a low energy content and is expensive to transport, so it's rarely transported.

Is Kosovo's power infrastructure in need of modernization?

Though the prospects of his latest foray into Kosovo's energy sector aren't clear, there is no question that the country's power infrastructure is in sore need of modernization. For reasons never fully explained, Kosovo decided in 2012 to sell its power transmission infrastructure to a Turkish consortium for EUR26 million.

His company Envidity, which focuses on clean energy, has applied for a licence to explore in Kosovo and produce synthetic fuel if significant coal deposits can be found. The Canadian company, of which Clark is chairman, said if the exploration was successful it could eventually produce up to 15.9 million litres (100,000 barrels) a day of high ...

This would make the Kosovo operation one of the largest of its kind in the world, and, according to Envidity, bring \$8 billion of investment to Kosovo.
