

What is dark energy and why is it important?

Among the keenest hopes is that it will help reveal the nature of dark matter, the mysterious invisible something responsible for generating extra gravity in the Universe; and dark energy, the mysterious invisible something responsible for driving the variably accelerating expansion of the Universe.

How much do we know about dark matter & dark energy?

"Dark matter makes up about a quarter of the Universe, and dark energy makes up another 70 percent, and we don't really know what either one is," says physicist Mark Maus of Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory and the University of California Berkeley.

How do astronomers know if dark energy is constant?

For dark energy, however, the challenge is to figure out not what it is but what it's like. In particular, astronomers want to know if dark energy changes over space and time, or whether it's constant. One way to study it is to measure so-called baryon acoustic oscillations.

When did astronomers discover dark energy?

Both teams announced their findings in 1998. Turner gave the "something" a nickname: dark energy. It stuck. Since then, astronomers have pursued the mystery of dark energy to the ends of the Earth--literally.

What is dark energy spectroscopic instrument (Desi)?

This brings us to the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory-led Dark Energy Spectroscopic Instrument (DESI), a huge international collaboration that is currently working to map the observable Universe to unravel its biggest secrets.
