

What is the average power capacity of a battery storage system?

For costs reported between 2013 and 2019, short-duration battery storage systems had an average power capacity of 12.4 MW, medium-duration systems had 6.4 MW, and long-duration battery storage systems had 4.7 MW. The average energy capacity for the short- and medium-duration battery storage systems were 4.7 MWh and 6.6 MWh, respectively.

How much energy does a battery storage system use?

The average for the long-duration battery storage systems was 21.2 MWh, between three and five times more than the average energy capacity of short- and medium-duration battery storage systems. How much battery storage will the US have in 2024?

Developers are expected to add another 15 GW of battery storage in 2024, and around 9 GW in 2025. US battery storage capacity has been growing since 2021 and is anticipated to increase by 89% by the end of this year if all planned energy storage systems are brought online.

How much battery capacity does the United States have?

The remaining states have a total of around 3.5 GW of installed battery storage capacity. Planned and currently operational U.S. utility-scale battery capacity totaled around 16 GW at the end of 2023. Developers plan to add another 15 GW in 2024 and around 9 GW in 2025, according to our latest Preliminary Monthly Electric Generator Inventory.

Will US battery storage capacity increase by 89%?

US battery storage capacity has been growing since 2021 and is anticipated to increase by 89% by the end of this year if all planned energy storage systems are brought online. California and Texas currently account for the majority of battery capacity additions.
