

How many MW solar power plant in Fiji?

EFL has planned for 5 MW solar power plant in Nadi, Fiji. This would require approximately 33,000 m<sup>2</sup> of land area and using Eq. 8.1, its generation potential is estimated to be around 9 GWh/annum. However, for diversifying Fiji's electricity supply sources, further capacity addition is needed for solar PV supported by wind and biomass.

How much does solar PV cost in Fiji?

Solar PV has many advantages such as it has no moving parts and therefore does not require extensive operation and maintenance; solar resource is free and abundant at most locations in Fiji. For Fiji, the current installation cost of rooftop solar PV grid connected system is around 3100-3500 FJD/kW.

How much does a 1 MW solar power plant cost?

The installation cost of a 1 MW solar power plant can vary significantly based on the factors mentioned above. As of 2021, the estimated average installation cost ranges from \$1 million to \$1.4 million. However, it is essential to note that costs can be significantly lower or higher depending on project-specific details.

Where are Fiji's New solar power projects located?

Three new solar power projects are initiated. These are located at Qeleloa, Viti Levu and Taveuni. The Qeleloa 5 MW PV-grid connected system is being developed by a local private solar firm under the purchase agreement with the Government of Fiji.

What is the largest solar PV system in Fiji?

The largest system to date is Six Senses Fiji Resort on Malolo Islands in the Mamanuca Group that has a 1 MW solar PV system with 4 MWh of Lithium ion battery storage system (SEANZ 2017).

How many solar panels are installed in Fiji?

In total, around 4 MW of solar PV is installed with some grid-connected solar systems planned and many off-grid solar system planned by Fiji Department of Energy with funding from Fijian government and overseas donor agencies.
