

What hydropower projects are being built in Fiji?

Existing hydropower projects in Fiji also include the 6-MW Wainakisou Power Station, which is scheduled for an upgrade that would increase both the head and storage capacity, and the 3-MW Nagado Power Station. Planned projects will add more than 25 percent additional energy generation from hydropower to the country's energy grid.

Does Fiji have a nuclear power station?

Fiji neither has any fossil fuel energy resources nor any nuclear power stations. It imports all its fuel requirements for transportation and electricity. Renewable energy resources are mainly used for electric power generation. Due to geographical location of Fiji, it has good renewable energy resources such as solar, wind, biomass and hydro.

How is energy provided in Fiji?

The provision of energy in Fiji is provided through electrical power grids consisting of microgrids installed in Government facilities and community-run in rural areas. Furthermore, diesel generators and solar home systems also are utilized as a way of power providers.

How do sugar mills generate electricity in Fiji?

Sugar mills used agricultural and wood factory waste to generate electricity for their consumption using a stream boiler power system. The excess power is sold to Energy Fiji Limited (EFL). It is reported that during the sugar cane crushing season FSC mills can generate power of about 48 MW.

What is Fiji's future power generation?

Hydropower, bioenergy, solar energy and wind power are the prominent renewables on which Fiji's future power generation would be based. The share of renewable energies in the urban power generation in the calendar year 2019 was about 53% (561.96 million units). 55.9% of the Fijian population lives in rural areas and settlements.

How much electricity does Fiji need?

By 2020 the electricity demand would reach to 1352 GW-hour (GWh) and a peak load demand of 256 MW, respectively [4]. The provision of energy in Fiji is provided through electrical power grids consisting of microgrids installed in Government facilities and community-run in rural areas.
