## Flywheel energy storage energy density limit

What is the energy density of a flywheel rotor?

The flywheel body material was graphite composite material, with an energy density of 11.67 Wh/kg. The carbon fiber epoxy resin composite flywheel rotor developed by the University of Maryland in the United States has successfully stored 20 kWh of energy, with a maximum speed of 46,345 rpm .

How much energy does a flywheel store?

Indeed, the development of high strength, low-density carbon fiber composites (CFCs) in the 1970s generated renewed interest in flywheel energy storage. Based on design strengths typically used in commercial flywheels, s max /r is around 600 kNm/kg for CFC, whereas for wrought flywheel steels, it is around 75 kNm/kg.

How do you calculate energy storage density for a flywheel?

Thanks to the unique advantages such as long life cycles, high power density, minimal environmental impact, and high power quality such as fast response and voltage stability, the flywheel/kinetic energy storage system (FESS) is gaining attention recently.

How does a flywheel energy storage system work?

The flywheel energy storage system mainly stores energy through the inertia of the high-speed rotation of the rotor. In order to fully utilize material strength to achieve higher energy storage density, rotors are increasingly operating at extremely high flange speeds.
