

What is a flywheel energy storage system?

Flywheel energy storage systems have a long working life if periodically maintained (>25 years). The cycle numbers of flywheel energy storage systems are very high (>100,000). In addition,this storage technology is not affected by weather and climatic conditions . One of the most important issues of flywheel energy storage systems is safety.

What are the potential applications of flywheel technology?
