

What is a flywheel-storage power system?

A flywheel-storage power system uses a flywheel for energy storage,(see Flywheel energy storage) and can be a comparatively small storage facility with a peak power of up to 20 MW. It typically is used to stabilize to some degree power grids,to help them stay on the grid frequency,and to serve as a short-term compensation storage.

What is a flywheel/kinetic energy storage system (fess)?

Thanks to the unique advantages such as long life cycles, high power density, minimal environmental impact, and high power quality such as fast response and voltage stability, the flywheel/kinetic energy storage system (FESS) is gaining attention recently.

How does Flywheel energy storage work?

Flywheel energy storage (FES) works by accelerating a rotor (flywheel) to a very high speed and maintaining the energy in the system as rotational energy.

What is a flywheel storage power plant?

In Ontario,Canada,Temporal Power Ltd. has operated a flywheel storage power plant since 2014. It consists of 10 flywheels made of steel. Each flywheel weighs four tons and is 2.5 meters high. The maximum rotational speed is 11,500 rpm. The maximum power is 2 MW. The system is used for frequency regulation.

How much power does a flywheel generate?

It was rated for 155 MW power and 0.93 power factor, for a pulsed duration of 9.7 s. In the following years, this flywheel was complemented with two more flywheels to utilise a flywheel generator system for high energy fusion experiments.

What is a 10 MJ flywheel energy storage system?

A 10 MJ flywheel energy storage system for high quality electric power and reliable power supply from the distribution network,was tested in the year 2000. It was able to keep the voltage in the distribution network within 98%-102% and had the capability of supplying 10 kW of power for 15 min .
