

Are flywheel energy storage systems suitable for commercial applications?

Among the different mechanical energy storage systems, the flywheel energy storage system (FESS) is considered suitable for commercial applications. An FESS, shown in Figure 1, is a spinning mass, composite or steel, secured within a vessel with very low ambient pressure.

What is a flywheel energy storage system (fess)?

The flywheel energy storage system (FESS) is one such storage system that is gaining popularity. This is due to the increasing manufacturing capabilities and the growing variety of materials available for use in FESS construction. How much energy does a flywheel store?

Indeed, the development of high strength, low-density carbon fiber composites (CFCs) in the 1970s generated renewed interest in flywheel energy storage. Based on design strengths typically used in commercial flywheels,  $\sigma_{max}/r$  is around 600 kNm/kg for CFC, whereas for wrought flywheel steels, it is around 75 kNm/kg.

Can a flywheel improve energy quality?

The development of suitable FESS is being researched to improve the overall system stability and energy quality in current solar and wind energy systems. The flywheel can be introduced into a wind farm setup to store excess energy during peak production times, to later be released back into the grid at times when there is no wind.
