

Flywheel energy storage technology is a form of mechanical energy storage that works by accelerating a rotor (flywheel) to a very high speed and maintaining the energy in the system as kinetic energy.

The Dinglun Flywheel Energy Storage Power Station broke ground in July last year. China Energy Construction Shanxi Power Engineering Institute and Shanxi Electric Power Construction Company carried out the construction works. BC New Energy was the technology provider and Shenzhen Energy Group was the main investor.

While many papers compare different ESS technologies, only a few research , studies design and control flywheel-based hybrid energy storage systems. Recently, Zhang et al. present a hybrid energy storage system based on compressed air energy storage and FESS.

The flywheel rotor is the energy storage part of FESS, and the stored electrical energy E (J) can be expressed as: (1) $E = 0.5 J \omega^2$ (J (kg m²) represents the moment of inertia of the flywheel rotor body, and ω (rad/s) is the rotational angular velocity of the flywheel rotor.

The principle of rotating mass causes energy to store in a flywheel by converting electrical energy into mechanical energy in the form of rotational kinetic energy. 39 The energy fed to an FESS is mostly dragged from an electrical energy source, which may or may not be connected to the grid.

Boeing has developed a 5 kW h/3 kW small superconducting maglev flywheel energy storage test device. SMB is used to suspend the 600 kg rotor of the 5 kWh/250 kW FESS, but its stability is insufficient in the experiment, and damping needs to be increased.
