

Are phase change materials suitable for thermal energy storage?

Phase change materials (PCMs) having a large latent heat during solid-liquid phase transition are promising for thermal energy storage applications. However, the relatively low thermal conductivity of the majority of promising PCMs ( $< 10 \text{ W/(m} \cdot \text{K)}$ ) limits the power density and overall storage efficiency.

Are phase change materials suitable for thermal comfort?

They concluded that to suit thermal comfort requirements, the selected core materials (shown in Table 6) are quite satisfactory for most of the textile products as well as clothing. As selected phase change materials are non-corrosive, non-toxic, have no unpleasant odor easily available, and are chemically inert.

Are phase change materials suitable for heating & cooling applications?

The research, design, and development (RD&D) for phase change materials have attracted great interest for both heating and cooling applications due to their considerable environmental-friendly nature and capability of storing a large amount of thermal energy in small volumes as widely studied through experiments [7,8].

How to reduce phase change latent heat of cold storage material?

The PCMs in these applications need to be with the lower phase change temperatures, which however, reduce the latent heat of phase change. This can be addressed by the addition of inorganic salts to the water which helps reduce the phase change temperature of cold storage material without affecting its phase change latent heat.

What is phase change energy storage wood (PCSW)?

Wang et.al. , prepared a phase change energy storage wood (PCSW) by incorporating microPCM into balsa wood using vacuum impregnation method. Balsa wood has low density and high porosity, its porosity is further improved by delignification using a solution consisting of sodium hydroxide and sodium sulphite.

How do phase change composites convert solar energy into thermal energy?

Traditional phase change composites for photo-thermal conversion absorb solar energy and transform it into thermal energy at the top layers. The middle and bottom layers are heated by long-distance thermal diffusion.
