How to secure compressed gas cylinders in storage?

An accepted safe method for securing compressed gas cylinders in storage is as follows: Nesting of compressed gas cylinder by positioning them in a tight mass using a contiguous three-point contact system.

Where should compressed gas cylinders be stored?

Stored in a ventilated cabinet or enclosure (such as a certified chemical fume hood). For small compressed gas cylinders that do not fit the above classification, they may be stored in the laboratory on specifically designed racks for the storage of such compressed gas cylinders (Figure 20), for example lecture bottles, where they may be stored.

Do you need PPE when storing compressed gas cylinders?

Therefore, it's essential to wear the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when handling cylinders and compressed gases. All appropriate firefighting, personnel safety and first aid equipment should be available in case of emergencies. Follow all Federal, State and local regulations concerning the storage of compressed gas cylinders.

How can compressed gas system equipment be arranged?

Compressed gas system equipment may be arranged directly with the equipment supplier. Per the requirements or recommendations of federal, state or city authorities, industry experts and EH&S, gas monitoring and leak detection equipment or specific engineering controls, such as ventilated cabinets or custom.

Where can I find information about compressed gas handling?

The Compressed Gas Association (CGA) offers publications on handling compressed gases such as pamphlet P-1, "Safe Handling of Compressed Gases in Containers," and they also sell videos on compressed gas subject matter.

How do you transport a compressed gas cylinder in a laboratory?

Persons while moving within the laboratory or building. Never lift a cylinder by its cap. When moving compressed gas cylinders, use a handcart designed and designated for cylinder transport (Figure 21), to minimize the risk of dropping, falling or striking a cylinder against other cylinders or objects.
