

What is Air Liquide doing in Germany?

Air Liquide is currently building a 20 (+10) MW electrolysis plant in Oberhausen. Green hydrogen can be produced from the fall of 2023 onwards. Funding of the pipeline by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Protection as part of the real laboratory of the energy turnaround.

Who buys medical oxygen in Germany?
