What is Greece's first battery energy storage auction?

Greece has released its first battery energy storage auction for 400 MW. This is the first competitive process for energy storage in Southeastern Europe. Two more rounds are expected in 2023. The Greek Regulatory Authority for Waste, Energy and Water (RAWEW) has published the country's first round of battery storage auctions.

Does Greece have a 1 GW energy storage program?

The auction is part of Greece's 1 GW energy storage program. The country announced its 1 GW energy storage programin the summer with three separate tenders featuring 400 MW,300 MW and 300 MW of capacity. The first tender awarded 12 energy storage projects in August, with 411,79 MW of capacity in total.

What is Greece's energy storage program?

Greece's energy storage program will draw EUR341 million (\$372.3 million) from the European Union's post-pandemic recovery fund, which was approved last year by the European Commission. The program's first and second tenders will focus on standalone energy storage projects connected to the Greek electricity transmission network.

Does Greece have a battery storage pipeline?

Greece has emerged as one of the countries with the largest pipeline of battery storage projects, but as yet there has been little activity on the ground. This is changing as the long-awaited storage subsidy auctions have started, with the first projects being awarded support for both investment and operating costs.

Should Greece invest in energy storage facilities?

Currently there is a growing interest for investments in storage facilities in Greece. Licensed projects mostly consist of Li-ion battery energy storage systems (BESS), either stand-alone or integrated in PVs, as well as PHS facilities .

Does Greece have an energy storage system?

Greece's energy storage schemeallows projects from the European Economic Area (EEA) outside of Greece, provided there is an electricity interconnection and fully coupled power grids between Greece and the EEA country. Currently, only Bulgaria meets these expectations.

Therefore, rather belatedly, Greece has turned its attention to energy storage. So far, the country is running a 1 GW program targeting standalone, front of the meter batteries. Greece has already run two tenders ...
