

Is energy storage a viable resource for future power grids?

With declining technology costs and increasing renewable deployment, energy storage is poised to be a valuable resource on future power grids--but what is the total market potential for storage technologies, and what are the key drivers of cost-optimal deployment?

What is grid-scale storage?

Grid-scale storage refers to technologies connected to the power grid that can store energy and then supply it back to the grid at a more advantageous time - for example, at night, when no solar power is available, or during a weather event that disrupts electricity generation.

What are the benefits of grid-connected energy storage?

Grid-connected energy storage provides indirect benefits through regional load shaping, thereby improving wholesale power pricing, increasing fossil thermal generation and utilization, reducing cycling, and improving plant efficiency.

What could drive future grid-scale storage deployment?

By 2050, annual deployment ranges from 7 to 77 gigawatts. To understand what could drive future grid-scale storage deployment, NREL modeled the techno-economic potential of storage when it is allowed to independently provide three grid services: capacity, energy time-shifting, and operating reserves.

Is pumped-storage hydropower catching up with grid-scale batteries?

Pumped-storage hydropower is still the most widely deployed storage technology, but grid-scale batteries are catching up. The total installed capacity of pumped-storage hydropower stood at around 160GW in 2021. Global capability was around 8500GWh in 2020, accounting for over 90% of total global electricity storage.

Does storage add value to the grid?

They found storage adds the most value to the grid and deployment increases when the power system allows storage to simultaneously provide multiple grid services and when there is greater solar photovoltaic (PV) penetration.
