

What is grid Resilience & Innovation Partnerships (grip)?

On October 18, 2023, the U.S. Department of Energy announced up to \$3.46 billion in Grid Resilience and Innovation Partnerships (GRIP) Program investments for 58 projects across 44 states to strengthen electric grid resilience and reliability across America. This includes 16 projects selected under Grid Resilience Utility and Industry Grants.

How are grip projects selected?

The selections are made through Grid Innovation Program grants, one of three GRIP funding mechanisms, that seek to deploy projects that use innovative approaches to transmission, storage, and distribution infrastructure to enhance grid resilience and reliability. How much does DOE's grip program cost?

The grants from DOE's \$10.5 billion GRIP program -- funded by the bipartisan infrastructure law -- mark the second funding round under the program. In October, DOE awarded nearly \$3.5 billion in grants to support 58 projects in 44 states.

What are examples of thermal energy storage systems?

Liquids - such as water - or solid material - such as sand or rocks - can store thermal energy. Chemical reactions or changes in materials can also be used to store and release thermal energy. Water tanks in buildings are simple examples of thermal energy storage systems.

What is mechanical energy storage?

Mechanical energy storage harnesses motion or gravity to store electricity. For example, a flywheel is a rotating mechanical device that is used to store rotational energy that can be called up instantaneously.

What is thermal energy storage?

Thermal energy storage is used particularly in buildings and industrial processes. It involves storing excess energy - typically surplus energy from renewable sources, or waste heat - to be used later for heating, cooling or power generation. Liquids - such as water - or solid material - such as sand or rocks - can store thermal energy.

This type of energy storage converts the potential energy of highly compressed gases, elevated heavy masses or rapidly rotating kinetic equipment. Different types of mechanical energy storage technology include: ...
