How much mass does gunpowder have?

Gunpowder has 3MJ/kg3 M J /k g or so. It means you have to add about 35% 35 % to get the right estimate for the mass of equivalent gunpowder. If you could release the energy from the batteries very quickly,the explosion could be equally devastating as the corresponding gunpowder and TNT except that batteries can't release energy this quickly.

Why do gunpowder grains burn so slowly?

High-speed camera studies show that the gunpowder grains themselves burn comparatively slowly in a layer-wise fashion and suggest that the rapid propagation of the reaction from grain to grain is due to the emission of a hot spray of molten droplets of potassium salts.

How were gunpowder recipes used in a replica cannon?

Gunpowder recipes were prepared and used in a replica cannon that was manufactured and operated according to medieval records. Post-firing residues were collected from the bomb calorimeter and the cannon in efforts to further characterize recipe energetics using DSC.

Does black gunpowder strengthen all powders?
