

What does the Guyana Energy Agency do?

The Guyana Energy Agency continues to support national efforts in transforming the country's sustainable low-carbon pathway and the energy sector, as it contributes to providing cleaner, affordable energy access for all, as well as promoting energy efficiency and conservation practices.

What is the energy policy of Guyana?

Guyana's energy policy is the main policy that governs the energy sector in Guyana. There is currently no policy that specifically safeguards the sustainable exploitation of hydrocarbons. A Petroleum Law was formulated in 1998, but it requires revisiting and updating in light of the new oil and gas sector. (A4.7.1)

What is the gas-to-energy project in Guyana?

Our operations in Guyana are helping to supply the world's energy needs by producing more than 600,000 barrels of oil a day. The Gas-to-Energy project is expected to greatly improve the quality of life for the people of Guyana.

How many barrels of oil are produced a day in Guyana?

More than 100 miles offshore Guyana, three of the world's largest, best-in-class floating production storage and offloading (FPSO) vessels - the Liza Unity, the Liza Destiny and Prosperity - are producing more than 600,000 barrels of oil every day - up from 370,000 just one year ago.

How many solar homes are distributed in Guyana?

The GEA supported the implementation of a massive electrification project to supply, deliver, and distribute 30,000 solar home energy systems to hinterland and riverine communities in Guyana. A total of 26,398 units were distributed as of December 2023.

What did the GEA do for Guyana?

These advancements not only addressed rising electricity demand, but also expanded renewable-energy access across local communities.
