

I am looking at my newly installed but but not sealed patio door that is not screwed, not plumb-ed and not leveled and I am trying to understand why you need the entire door to ...

If your walls are not plumb, add furring strips to create a level, grid-like surface. These steps will also provide additional rigidity to your wall. Use either 1" x 2" or 1" x 4" kiln-dried lumber of 1/2" ...

I'm hanging paper from left to right, fixin' to turn this corner and place a new strip to the right of the corner. The corner is waaay out of plumb, meaning that the wall on the left sl...

Most likely, the door is not "plumb" meaning that the hinges do not line up as they should. The door frame and door are tilted and the unbalanced weight of the door causes the door to close ...

This LED level literally tells you when you're off. It lights up red when it's not level or plumb, yellow when you're close, and green when you've nailed it. You can see it from almost any angle, ...
