Use a picture rail if you have one. Some older plaster walls have a thin strip of wood that runs around the perimeter of a room, usually between 1 inch (2.5 cm) to 1 foot (30 cm) below the edge of the ceiling. If your room has this, you can simply drive a screw through the wood, and use this to hang things. For instance, drive a screw into the strip on the spot just above where you want to hang a picture... You can raise or lower the wire to get the picture to the correct height.
