

How many solar panels are there in Antarctica?

The first Australian solar farm in Antarctica was switched on at Casey research station in March 2019. The system of 105 solar panels, mounted on the northern wall of the 'green store', provides 30 kW of renewable energy into the power grid. That's about 10% of the station's total demand.

Can solar power be installed in the Antarctic?

Temperatures below -89°C, winds over 200km/h, extreme variances in hours of sunlight, with up to 16 hours in the summer and only two during winter, pose tremendous challenges for both research teams and equipment. Can solar panels run in Arctic and Antarctica?

In fact, some studies suggest that cooler temperatures can help solar panels run more efficiently. Instead, solar panels rely on solar radiation to produce energy. So, the question isn't whether the Arctic and Antarctica are warm enough, but whether they get enough sun exposure. The fact is that we can use solar panels at the poles.
