

Which Hongkong quay cranes have solar panels?

(Hong Kong, 10 Jul 2023) Hongkong International Terminals (HIT) announced the arrival of two brand new quay cranes, representing an investment of HK\$78 million, which are Hong Kong's first quay cranes equipped with solar panels on top of machinery house.

How many container terminals are there in Hong Kong?

Container terminals (CTs) are situated in the Kwai Chung-Tsing Yi basin. There are nine terminals operated by five different operators, namely Modern Terminals Ltd (MTL), Hongkong International Terminals Ltd (HIT), COSCO-HIT Terminals (Hong Kong) Ltd (CHT), Goodman DP World Hong Kong Ltd and Asia Container Terminals Ltd (ACT).

How long does a container ship take in Hong Kong?

The average turnaround time for container vessels in Hong Kong is about 10 hours. For conventional vessels working in mid-stream at buoys or anchorages, it is 42 and 52 hours respectively. The port has been one of the busiest container ports in the world for many years, and at times the busiest.

How many TEUs are handled in the Kwai Chung-Tsing Yi container terminals?

In 2023, the Kwai Chung-Tsing Yi Container Terminals handled over 11 million TEUs, representing about 77% of the port container throughput. The remaining 23% was handled at mid-stream sites, the river trade terminal, PCWAs, buoys and anchorages, and other wharves. Container terminals (CTs) are situated in the Kwai Chung-Tsing Yi basin.

How many quays are there in HKSAR?

PCWAs are currently situated at six different locations, providing a combined total quay length of 4,828 metres. They are managed by the Marine Department of the HKSAR Government. Class B GMBs - for vessels up to 137 m in length with drafts between 6.4 m and 9.1 m.
