As with chilled water storage, water can be heated and stored during periods of low thermal demand and then used during periods of high demand, ensuring that all thermal energy from the CHP system is efficiently utilized. Hot water storage coupled with CHP is especially attractive in cold northern climates that have high space heating requirements.

However, a recent meta-analysis on studies of thermochemical heat storage suggests that salt hydrates offer very low potential for thermochemical heat storage, that absorption processes have prohibitive performance for long-term heat storage, and that thermochemical storage may not be suitable for long-term solar heat storage in buildings.

What is sensitive heat storage (SHS)?

Sensible heat storage (SHS) is the most straightforward method. It simply means the temperature of some medium is either increased or decreased. This type of storage is the most commercially available out of the three; other techniques are less developed. The materials are generally inexpensive and safe.
