

What happened at California's largest lithium-ion battery energy storage facility?

A fire at a California lithium-ion battery energy storage facility once described as the world's largest has burned for five days, prompting evacuation orders. The fire broke out on Wednesday at the 250MW Gateway Energy Storage facility owned by grid infrastructure developer LS Power in San Diego.

Does battery storage have a problem with fires?

Here is what you need to know. Battery storage is a key piece of California's clean energy transition. But there's a problem with fires. A fire at Valley Center Energy Storage Facility in San Diego County is the latest in a series of incidents; advocates insist problems will get ironed out in time.

Are battery energy storage systems a fire hazard?

Cross-Safety.org wrote in their report "CROSS Safety Report Battery Energy Storage System concerns" in May 2023 that a safety panel in the UK agreed that "there are significant fire safety concerns related to BESSs.

Is battery storage a 'thermal runaway'?

State policymakers are still bullish on battery storage but concede that issues leading to "thermal runaway" -- where excessive heat inside a battery leads to a chemical reaction that spreads to other batteries in a chain reaction -- need to be resolved. "The stakes are high," said David Hochschild, chair of the California Energy Commission.

What is the largest battery energy storage project in the world?

The San Diego battery facility came online in 2020 and was billed at the time by grid infrastructure developer LS Power as the largest battery energy storage project in the world. Using LG Chem Lithium-ion cells, it beat the previous record held by a 150MW project in Australia, although has since been surpassed by other facilities.
