

How can Apple Park save energy?

For example, modern LED bulbs will be used for lighting, which according to calculations, will save an average of 25% compared to older technologies. Using Bloom Energy batteries and backup generators will ensure Apple Park's energy independence so that they will not be left without power even in the event of a total grid failure.

Is Apple Park energy efficient?

Apple Park is one of the most energy-efficient buildings in the world, or at least that's what Apple calls it. Special ventilation system technology ensures that the building does not require any heating or air conditioning for nine months of the year. The main building is shaped like a circle and has more than 1.6 kilometres of circumference.

What makes Apple Park unique?

Apple loved glass, so all the buildings are made primarily of glass. Apple Park is 80% green, so 30 acres of greenery and an artificial pond are in the courtyard. Of course, there are 9,000 trees in total. Apart from the materials used (the building has about 6 kilometres of glass), what is unique about the project is its energy independence.

Where is Apple building a data center?

Apple recently announced plans to build a 400,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art data center in Waukegan, Iowa, that will run entirely on renewable energy from day one. In Prineville, Oregon, the company signed a 200-megawatt power purchase agreement for an Oregon wind farm, the Montague Wind Power Project, set to come online by the end of 2019.
