How does a switching power supply work?

In switching power supply designs, the input voltage is no longer reduced; instead, it's rectified and filtered at the input. Then the voltage goes through a chopper, which converts it into a high-frequency pulse train. Before the voltage reaches the output, it's filtered and rectified once again.

How do AC/DC switching power supplies work?

AC/DC switching power supplies are currently the most efficient way of transforming AC power to DC power. The power is converted in three stages: Input rectification: This process takes the AC mains voltage and converts it into a DC rectified wave using a diode bridge.

Why is a switch made out of an electrical conductor?

As we already know, an electrical conductor is a material that allows electric charge to flow through it easily. All metals, and some nonmetals, conduct electricity. If a switch is made out of an electrical conductor, it will allow electricity to be transferred through it when it is closed.
