Why has the US sped up the return of 4 million barrels?

WASHINGTON, Dec 1 (Reuters) - The U.S. Department of Energy has sped up the return of 4 million barrels of oil to the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, from a previous exchange of crude to energy companies, as it seeks to replenish the stockpile after a record drawdown last year, it said on Friday.

How long does it take for oil to enter the US market?

It can take only 13 days from a presidential decision for the first oil to enter the country's market, according to the US Department of Energy. Under a sale, the Energy Department usually holds an online auction in which energy companies bid on the oil. Under a swap, oil companies take crude but are required to return it, plus interest.

How many barrels of crude oil were sold?

One batch of oil, totaling 950,000 barrels, was sold on April 21 to Unipec America, a Houston-based, Chinese-owned company. Other batches of crude oil, amounting to about 4 million barrels, were sold to companies based in other countries. What are the critics saying? More than two months later, critics of Biden pounced.

How many barrels of crude oil was shipped to Italy?

Reuters reported that, in June, the company shipped about 470,000 barrels of the crude oil it bought to Italy, according to government data. The news agency found that other companies that bought reserve oil also made shipments to the Netherlands, India and China.
