Which sectors use the most energy in Brazil?

In Brazil, the industrial and transportation sectors use most of the energy. Crude oil and other petroleum liquids production contributes significantly to Brazil's total energy production, accounting for 54.0% of total energy production and 44.2% of total energy consumption in 2021 (Table 1).

How much renewable power does Brazil have?

In total, Brazil had an operating renewable capacity of 194 gigawatts as of end of that year. Most of Brazil's renewable capacity comes from its hydropower plants, which were responsible for roughly 63 percent of the country's electricity production in 2022.

How much electricity does Brazil generate from fossil fuels?

Brazil generated 145,386 gigawatt-hours (GWh) of electricity from fossil fuels in the same year, accounting for 22% of total electricity generation. During periods of low water availability or high electricity demand, electricity from fossil fuels is frequently used to supplement hydroelectric power.

Why is Brazil's natural gas market expanding?

Brazil's natural gas and liquefied natural gas (LNG) market is expanding because of rising domestic consumption, infrastructure development, and market reforms. Natural gas accounted for 7% of Brazil's total energy production in 2021, up from 5% in 2011, and natural gas accounted for 12% of total energy consumption in 2021, up from 8% in 2011.

What is Brazil's energy mix?

Brazil's energy mix is diverse; hydropower, fossil fuels, biofuels, wind energy, and solar power all make significant contributions (Table 1). Brazil's total energy production increased by an average annual growth rate of 1.5% from 2011 to 2021.

What is Brazil's natural gas supply?

Brazil's natural gas supply is made up of domestic production, Bolivian imports, and LNG cargoes. Brazil's natural gas production reached 839 billion cubic feet (Bcf) in 2021, up by 1% from 2020. Three basins drive the country's natural gas production: Santos, Campos, and Espírito Santo.
