

How to calculate watt-hours for energy storage

What is a watt hour calculator?

Our watt hour calculator allows you to use electric charge in milliamp or amp hours and voltage in volts to calculate the energy in watt-hours or joules. Amp hours - the shortened name of ampere-hour - indicates how much charge can flow through a battery per one hour.

There is something else to consider, concerning the type of battery used. There is a general distinction between two kinds of batteries, made from two different materials: Lead-acid and Lithium-ion.

How do you convert watt hours to Watts?

Multiply the charge in amp hours by the voltage in volts. The result is watt hours. You can use the second method when you are studying energy in terms of power over time. Multiply the power in watts by the time in hours. The result is energy in watt hours. How do you convert Wh to watts?

How do you determine battery capacity?

A common way of specifying battery capacity is to provide the battery capacity as a function of the time in which it takes to fully discharge the battery (note that in practice the battery often cannot be fully discharged). The temperature of a battery will also affect the energy that can be extracted from it.

How do you calculate a battery Ah?

To calculate amp hours, you need to know the voltage of the battery and the amount of energy stored in the battery. Multiply the energy in watt-hours by voltage in volts, and you will obtain amp hours. Alternatively, if you have the capacity in mAh and you want to make a battery Ah calculation, simply use the equation: $Ah = (\text{capacity in mAh}) / 1000$.
