

## How to get grease off outdoor stainless steels

To protect the stainless steel from rust and corrosion, you can apply a thin layer of stainless steel cleaner or oil to the grill's surface. Wipe off any excess with a clean cloth.

Once you have cleaned it to bare metal it will re-passivate itself. If you have straw-colored or bluish tinted oxides on the stainless from welding or soldering, it should be cleaned off with a ...

To remove grease stains from stainless steel surfaces, start by mixing equal parts vinegar and water, and apply it directly to the stain for 10-15 minutes. Wipe away the excess with a soft cloth.
