What happens if fuel rods are spent in a nuclear reactor?

When fuel rods in a nuclear reactor are "spent," or no longer usable, they are removed from the reactor core and replaced with fresh fuel rods. The spent fuel rods are still highly radioactive and continue to generate significant heat for decades.

How do you store Spent nuclear fuel?

There are two acceptable storage methods for spent fuel after it is removed from the reactor core: Spent Fuel Pools- Currently, most spent nuclear fuel is safely stored in specially designed pools at individual reactor sites around the country. At Reactor - Licensees may use dry storage systems when approaching their pool capacity limit.

How do used fuel rods work?

Used fuel rods are placed at the bottom of a spent fuel pond to begin a process of cooling that will last for years. The highly specialised overhead gantry crane used to transport and position the fuel rods must offer complete reliability.

How do nuclear reactors keep fuel?

They are kept on racks in the pool, submerged in more than twenty feet of water, and water is continuously circulated to draw heat away from the rods and keep them at a safe temperature. Because no permanent repository for spent fuel exists in the United States, reactor owners have kept spent fuel at the reactor sites.
