How long does a UPS battery last?

Failing to maintain your UPS battery's charge will result in permanent loss of capacity within 18 and 30 months. If you are unwilling or unable to charge your battery while in storage, it is recommended the battery be stored at 50°F (10°C) or less. Doing so will slow the degradation cycle of the battery, and help to maximize its life expectancy.

How do you replace a battery on a UPS system?

Firstly, power down the UPS system and disconnect it from the electrical. Follow the manufacturer's guidelines to safely remove the old battery and install the new one accordingly. Once the new battery is installed, reconnect the UPS system and thoroughly test the new battery.
