The hydrogen produced electrolytically by nuclear energy is called "yellow hydrogen",which is zero-carbon. LucidCatalyst has reported in 2020 that the cost of hydrogen from nuclear power is 2 USD/kg,which is competitive to "grey hydrogen",0.7-1.6 USD/kg without costing CO 2 emissions .
