

What is hydrogen storage?

Hydrogen storage is a key enabling technology for the advancement of hydrogen and fuel cell technologies in applications including stationary power, portable power, and transportation.

Where can hydrogen be stored?

Hydrogen can also be stored on the surfaces of solids (by adsorption) or within solids (by absorption). HFTO conducts research and development activities to advance hydrogen storage systems technology and develop novel hydrogen storage materials.

Are hydrogen storage technologies sustainable?

The outcomes showed that with the advancements in hydrogen storage technologies and their sustainability implications, policymakers, researchers, and industry stakeholders can make informed decisions to accelerate the transition towards a hydrogen-based energy future that is clean, sustainable, and resilient.

Could a hydrogen storage facility supply 5m homes a day?

Mitsubishi and a partner have proposed a nearby facility to store green hydrogen sufficient to generate 150,000 megawatt-hours of electricity, which could supply 5m average US homes for a day. "Hydrogen is that one technology where you can actually do seasonal storage," said Paul Schultz of the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.

How many miles can hydrogen be stored in a car?

Initiatives such as the Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Technologies Office (HFTO) have focused on onboard hydrogen storage for over 300 miles of driving. Currently, materials such as SSHS and alternative storage methods are being investigated. The International Energy Agency has promoted the use of hydrogen for various applications.
