

Can thermal energy storage be used in electric vehicles?

In recent years, Thermal Energy Storage (TES) technology, as a passive thermal management solution, has attracted more and more attention for applications in EVs due to enhanced cycle life, high overall efficiency, simple control procedure, fast heating and cooling response time and low energy costs.

Can thermal batteries provide heat for EVs in cold environments?

Therefore, using thermal batteries with high energy storage density to provide heat for EVs in cold environments can reduce vehicle costs, increase driving range, and prolong battery life. This is especially so for large EVs with a high heat demand such as electric buses.

What is metal hydride-based thermal energy storage (TES)?

Metal hydride-based TES can provide both heating and cooling, and the heat storage density at material level is very high. In addition, it can realize long-term thermal energy storage. However, the current maturity of this technology is very low, and it is difficult to achieve a high energy density at device level.

Why do cooling systems need thermal energy storage?

To address these issues, thermal energy storage (TES) units can be incorporated into cooling systems to act as a buffer between supply and demand and to provide flexibility. This enables the peak cooling demand to be shaved, electrical load to be shifted and electricity costs reduced.
