How can cold energy be stored?

It has wide applications not only for air conditioning use in buildings, vehicles, and other conditioned spaces, but also for the fresh and frozen food storage and transport. In general, the cold energy can be stored in sensible, latent and sorption forms.

What are sensible and latent thermal energy storage?

Sensible, latent, and thermochemical energy storages for different temperature ranges are investigated with a current special focus on sensible and latent thermal energy storages. Thermochemical heat storage is a technology under development with potentially high-energy densities.

What are the challenges of latent thermal energy storage?

One of the main challenges for latent thermal energy storages is the phase change itself which requires a separation of the storage medium and HTF. Furthermore, PCMs usually have a low thermal conductivity, which limits the heat transfer and power of the storage.

What are the advantages of iceberg condenser?

The iceberg shape like condenser can efficiently collect vapor in hot weather. The introduction of a TG between photothermal and evaporation layer can decrease heat loss. Excellent durability performance in solar steam desalination. This ISWG may pave the way for industrial desalination.

What are the average power densities for heat storage and cold storage?

The average power densities for heat storage and cold storage are 279.66 W/kg and 242.95 W/kg, respectively. Meanwhile, the average energy densities for heat storage and cold storage are as high as 686.86 kJ/kg and 597.13 kJ/kg, respectively, superior to the current sensible/latent heat energy storage.
