

How much do solar panels cost in Indonesia?

Across the world, the cost of solar panels is declining, and Indonesia is no different. The price of solar modules dropped from USD 4.12 per watt in 2008 to USD 0.17 per watt in 2020. This translates to lower costs for solar energy, which are around USD 0.04 per kWh.

How much solar power does Indonesia have?

As of May 2024, Indonesia's installed rooftop solar capacity was only 0.192 MWp, according to research firm Rystad Energy. Are the goals achievable? Indonesia previously set renewable energy targets, hoping that by 2025, the country's share of renewable power generation in the energy mix will reach 23%.

Why is solar energy important in Indonesia?

The economic aspect of solar energy, particularly the cost of solar panels, plays a critical role in its adoption. This price reduction is crucial for the decarbonisation of Indonesia's energy sector and signifies solar power's role in the global climate transition.

What is solar energy development in Indonesia?

To date, nearly all solar energy project development in Indonesia has revolved around extending sustainable energy access to remote, off-grid communities by deploying solar home systems (SHS) or solar-plus-storage micro- or mini-grids.

What is Indonesia's solar energy plan?

This progress is part of Indonesia's solar energy plan, which targets 5 GW of installed capacity by 2030. The growth of solar power in Indonesia reflects not just a commitment to shift away from its fossil fuel-dominated energy system but also recognises the immense potential the solar energy holds in the Indonesian archipelago.

Can Indonesia increase installed solar capacity?

Despite the challenges, Indonesia still has the potential to increase installed solar capacity. According to Rystad Energy's analysis, the cost of large-scale ground-mounted solar projects in Indonesia has declined from about \$2.6/MW in 2013 to \$0.8/MW in 2024, a price that is in the range of the total global cost of solar (\$0.5 to \$1.8/MW).

The report indicates that as of August 2024, there are 16.92 GW of announced solar projects in preparation nationwide, with an anticipated addition of 350 GW to 550 GW of solar capacity by 2050. It also noted that Indonesia's solar-related investments nearly doubled, increasing from \$68 million in 2021 to approximately \$135 million in 2023.

The Indonesia Solar Energy Association (ISEA) predicts installed capacity for rooftop solar panels could top 1,000 MW next year and rise by between 3,000 MW and 5,000 MW per year starting in 2025.

ISEO 2023 stated that the progress of Indonesia's solar energy can be seen from the decline in the price of solar electricity obtained through a power purchase agreement (PPA) made by PT PLN (Persero) with Independent Power Producers (IPP). Between 2015 and 2022, solar PPA prices declined by 78%, from \$0.25/kWh to \$0.056/kWh.

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
