Because inductors store the kinetic energy of moving electrons in the form of a magnetic field, they behave quite differently than resistors (which simply dissipate energy in the form of heat) ...

Unlike resistance, inductance cannot convert this energy into heat or light. Instead, the energy is stored in the magnetic field as the rising current forces the magnetic lines of force to expand against their tendency to become as short ...

Energy Efficiency: Store and release energy, helping to reduce power losses in circuits. Noise Reduction: Minimize electrical noise, promoting cleaner signals and better performance. ...

It is worth noting that both capacitors and inductors store energy, in their electric and magnetic fields, respectively. A circuit containing both an inductor (L) and a capacitor (C) can oscillate without a source of emf by shifting the energy ...
