Can industrial hemp be used for biofuels?

Industrial hemp as an energy crop for producing biofuels(bioethanol,biodiesel,and methane) and solid biofuels (briquettes and pellets) were the most extensively studied products under the feasibility analysis category (n = 13).

What is the energy yield of industrial hemp?

The energy yield of solid fuel from industrial hemp is very high, approximately 100 GJ/ha/y[115], which is superior to Lucerne and clover grass ley, but inferior to sugar beet and maize, each of which is a competing energy crop.

Can hemp be used as a bioenergy feedstock?

Additionally, several studies show hemp's viability as a bioenergy feedstock, but research on co-production systems such as biorefineries for industrial hemp with multiple types of bioenergy and consumer products are not considered in the literature, unlike other energy crops such as soya [33] and oil palm [34].

Can industrial hemp be used for bioenergy in Canada?

An increase in demand for industrial hemp could stabilize the once-niche crop to a level where bioenergy applications are economically competitive, thus a review such as this will direct policy makers and future research towards the best applications of industrial hemp for the benefit of Canadian agriculture.

How are industrial hemp plants harvested?

To produce flower buds and floral materials, wide branches and leaves are encouraged. The hemp is planted more sparsely, approximately three to five feet apart, so the plant can branch more widely .
