

What is the Red Sea New City Energy Storage Project?

The Red Sea New City energy storage project is one of the key highlights of the Vision 2030 blueprint by Saudi Arabia, which aims to reduce the country's dependence on oil, diversify its economy and develop public service sectors such as health, education and infrastructure.

What is the largest microgrid energy storage project in the world?

As a cornerstone of Saudi Vision 2030, the Red Sea project stands as the world's largest microgrid energy storage project, with a storage capacity of 1.3 GWh. Huawei provided a complete set of equipment and consulting services for the project, including 400 MW PV inverters, 1.3 GWh ESSs, and transformer stations.

Huawei and SEPCO III Electric Power Construction Co Ltd successfully signed the Saudi Red Sea New City energy storage project during the Global Digital Power Summit 2021 in Dubai, according to a statement released on Huawei's official WeChat account.

What is the Neom Red Sea project?

This 1300 MWh off-grid energy storage project is the largest of its kind in the world and represents a milestone in the global energy storage industry. The NEOM Red Sea project has been listed as a key element in Saudi Vision 2030. The developer is ACWA Power, with SEPCO III fulfilling the role of EPC.

What is the Red Sea project?

The Red Sea Project is set to transform the region into a beacon of sustainable tourism. With plans to complete by 2030, the project envisions the creation of Red Sea City, featuring 50 hotels with 8,000 rooms and more than 1,000 residential properties across 22 islands and six inland sites.

How many hotels will be in the Red Sea?

The development will seemingly include 50 hotels when complete, and will be powered solely by wind and solar energy. The complex will rely on the world's largest battery storage facility at 1000 MWh, which is being supplied by the Red Sea Development Company (TRSDC).
